### Slide 5: How Our Village Engages and Works Together

- Statutory Notifications
  - California statutes require employers and public assistance programs to provide information on anti-poverty tax credits and free filing options
  - Likely to be the most successful outreach effort with the least costs
- Grants
  - California funds grants annually for local community-based organizations to allow for local outreach to community members

- Confirmed California's continued participation with the IRS
- Project Planning and Timeline Complete
  - 2025 Filing Season (2024 Tax Year) IRS will send California taxpayers to FTB's
    CalFile webpage to securely and conveniently file their CA return for free.
  - 2025 Filing Season Marketing Plan will highlight Direct File/ CalFile and the opportunity for Californians to file for free.
  - 2026 Filing Season (2025 Tax Year) Our enhanced CalFile will be released providing an integrated handoff from the IRS Direct File.
