You may qualify for cash-back tax credits that can increase your refund when you file your taxes

The California Earned Income Tax Credit (CalEITC), state Young Child Tax Credit (YCTC), state Foster Youth Tax Credit (FYTC) and the federal EITC can combine to put hundreds or even thousands of extra dollars in your pocket.

The amount of CalEITC you may be eligible for depends on how much money you earn from work. You may also be eligible if you:

- Are at least 18 years old or have a child.
- Work for an employer or work for yourself.
- Have a Social Security Number or a federal Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN).
- Lived in California at least half the tax year.

If you qualify for CalEITC and have a child under the age of six, you may also be eligible for the YCTC. For tax year 2022 forward, if you meet all other requirements you do not need income to be eligible for the Young Child Tax Credit.
