SUBJECT

Court Ordered Debt Collection Program

- Minor/Technical Amendment

SUMMARY

This bill would, under the Business and Professions Code (BPC), Government Code (GC), Penal Code (PC), Vehicle Code (VC), and Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC), among other changes, eliminate a number of administrative fees and costs imposed on a person related to involvement in the criminal justice system and would specify that the unpaid balance of specified fees or costs eliminated by these provisions be unenforceable and uncollectable.

ANALYSIS

The August 30, 2021, amendments added a coauthor, made conforming changes to related provisions in the GC, added a requirement to the PC that the trial court must hold a hearing to determine the ability of a defendant to pay the court ordered cost, made changes to the ignition interlock device program costs under the VC, made other nonsubstantive changes, and renumbered the sections of the bill.

The department's analysis of this bill, as introduced February 18, 2021, still applies.
